



## **New America School**

### **F-1 International Student Guidelines**

1. Admission:
  - Application
  - Proof of finances:
    - Bank statement that shows at least \$15,000 (\$8,000 for tuition + \$7,000 for living expenses)
    - Agreement of Financial Support from the student's sponsor
  - English language requirements:
    - Minimum score of 57 on the TOEFL IBT or 5.5 on IELTS
  - Copy of passport that is valid for at least six (6) months in the future
  - Immunization records (translated into English)
  - Transcripts from your school in your home country (translated into English)
  - \$100 application fee (non-refundable)
2. Students will *only* be admitted for August and January starts.
3. F-1 students are not allowed to enroll in English Language Acquisition courses. The I-20 will be issued for "Secondary – 53.0101 – Regular/General High School/Secondary Diploma Program".
4. As New America School (NAS) is a public charter school, F-1 students are only permitted to study up to 12 months *total* at any public school. (August 7, 2017 – June 1, 2018 or January 8, 2018 – December 20, 2018 at NAS)
5. F-1 students must enroll in a full course of study, which is at least six (6) credits.
6. Tuition:
  - \$800 tuition is due monthly.
  - Tuition is due according to the payment calendar.
  - Late payments will be assessed a \$100 late fee.
7. Attendance:
  - If a student misses 10 days in a row, they may be terminated.
  - If a student misses eight (8) days in a quarter, they may be placed on probation and terminated if attendance does not improve the following quarter.
8. Academics:
  - Students are expected to keep a 2.0 GPA or better per semester.
  - If a student falls below a 2.0 GPA, they may be placed on probation and terminated if grades do not improve the following semester.
9. Students must notify the administration at NAS and the NAS P/DSO within 10 days of changing addresses.

10. NAS does not provide on-campus work opportunities for F-1 students.

11. Students are expected to notify administrators at NAS and the NAS P/DSO if:

- They have issues that may interfere with their schoolwork
- They want to transfer to another NAS campus
- They are planning on leaving the country
- They wish to transfer to another educational institution
- They are withdrawing from NAS

12. F-1 students are not eligible for free bus passes from NAS or the Jared Polis scholarship.

I understand that I have to follow these guidelines. I understand that I cannot study English Language Acquisition and that I may not stay at New America School for more than 12 months.
